Here's How It Works ...

Families arrive at church. 6:30 PM Family Meal or 7:00 PM for Church

For safety, kids are checked in at our Kids desk.


6:30 PM Family Meal starts Each Wednesday we have a Family Meal time together before church starts. Our volunteers prepare a meal for everyone who wants to come. We sit together around tables, eat great food and talk to each other. It's like being part of one big family! It's great!



The menu changes each week, so we often put the menu on our church's Facebook page so you can know what we're having in advance. 7:00 PM- 8:15 PM Our classes start for **Mpact Girls** and **Royal Rangers**. That's also when **P.U.L.S.E. youth ministries** starts. That's our ministry for teens from 6th-12th grade. There's also an **Adult Bible study** that meets in the sanctuary.



Mpact girls meet in their own clubs (classrooms). Preschool clubs have their own classrooms. too. You can find your club's location on the back of this brochure. Our girls usually stay in their club rooms throughout the night to work on projects. memorize Bible verses and have fun together. Sometimes. they go outside (weather permitting, of course) for activities. or will use the fellowship hall for a game, activity or to do special stuff to earn their unit badges.



Royal Rangers head to their classrooms at the beginning of the night. You can find your group's location on the back of this brochure. Boys meet with their commanders (teachers) and do some preliminary things in their classrooms. Our Rangers do a lot of activities throughout the night (both indoor and outdoor) then close the evening in their classrooms with a lesson and Bible study.

If you can't get a ride, we have a **van ministry** to pick kids up. Our very dedicated volunteers usually have specific routes they follow. Van space is limited, so make sure you call the church to get a seat!
